## “Boarding My Cat”

Welcome. Thank you for choosing Shawnee Animal Clinic (SAC) to kennel your cat. We require boarding patients to be up-to-date on all vaccinations prior to boarding with us. If you would like your pet examined by a doctor while boarding, feline leukemia or feline aids testing or an intestinal parasite exam performed please let receptionist know immediately. All pets are monitored closely and boarded in separate kennels to minimize contact between pets. If your pet injures itself while boarding, we will treat at your expense. If your cat would suddenly become ill, during the stay, we will do our best to contact you immediately. If our staff cannot reach you, for any reason, your pet will be examined by one of our veterinarians and will be treated. We will do everything we can to ensure your cat has a pleasant stay at Shawnee Animal Clinic.

**Vaccinations:** All cats boarded at SAC must have proof of current vaccinations for rabies and fvrpc. We recommend yearly intestinal parasite screening and feline leukemia and feline aids testing. Please be aware any vaccinations given the day of arrival may not be affective. Our recommendations are all cats are vaccinated at least 2 weeks prior to boarding with us.

**Flea and Tick Prevention:** To prevent the spread of fleas in our facility, we will treat any boarding pet needed with Capstar upon admission to the boarding facility. The Capstar tablet will decrease the spread of adult fleas and will begin killing fleas within 30 minutes after giving tablet orally. If your pet is found to have ticks upon arrival, a tick preventative will be administered upon arrival at the pet owner’s expense.

**Bedding:** Your pet will be boarded in a small cat condo. Your cat will have a bed to sleep in and a litter box, which will be provided by SAC. All kennel bedding is provided by SAC. If you wish to bring your own bedding, you may, but it may be lost in the laundry as we change bedding multiple times a day. Condos are cleaned twice daily and as needed. If you need to leave a small carrier during your pets stay then please label your carrier, with a sharpie marker, prior to dropping pet off. The carrier label should include your cat’s name and your last name. **If you elect to leave toys please be advised that we cannot be responsible if toys are damaged or lost.**

**Feeding:** Your cat will be fed quality dry food. If your cat does not eat the dry food, we will try canned or special foods and give a high calorie supplement to ensure proper nutrition. If your pet requires this type of feeding for more than two meals per day then you will incur a charge for additional food used. If you wish to bring your own food then we will feed as directed by you.

**Medications:** If your cat requires medication, we will give medications as directed by owner. There is an additional fee to administer the medication daily.

**Bathing and Nail Trims:** If you would like to have your cats nails trimmed while boarding then please let our receptionist know so it can be indicated on the boarding card and consent form. Any pet boarding more than 48 hours will receive a complimentary bath prior to dismissal. Your pet will be bathed the morning of dismissal so if your schedule changes then please let us know. You will be charged for repetitive bathing.

**Payments:** Our payment policy is the bill can be paid when pet is dismissed and we require no deposit. Any long-term boarding patients need to provide a credit card number prior to the cat being admitted for boarding. Any additional charges on the invoice must be paid prior to your cat leaving our facility. We do not do any billing. We accept: Cash, Personal Check, Visa, Master Card, Discover and Care Credit.
